# ANNOUNCEMENT--1867-8.



THE regular course of instruction will begin on the first Monday in November, 1867, and end on the first day of March, 1868. The Museum, Cabinets, Library, Building and apparatus, are not only as perfect as ever, having been preserved intact during the recent war, but the College has received the addition of the private collection of Dr. Joseph Jones, numbering more than two thousand specimens and preparations, illustrating Comparative Anatomy and Physiology; also a number of splendid Anatomical Models, by Dr. T. B. Buchanan. The class of 1866-7, was very nearly double that of 1865-6, notwithstanding that, a large number of students, from Georgia, Alabama, Louisiana, Texas, and other States, were deterred from coming to Nashville, by the presence of Cholera at the opening of the last session. The prosperity of the institution has been equal to the expectations of its friends and officers.

The Faculty have resolved, without regard to expense, to keep this College in a condition to offer the best possible facilities to students for the attainment of a thorough medical education.

## P R E L I M I N A R Y   C O U R S E .

This will commence upon the first Monday in October, and will be free to every one who chooses to attend. Regular Lectures will be delivered during this course, the dissecting rooms will be kept in active operation under the Demonstrator of Anatomy, operations in Surgery performed before the class, and Hospital and Clinical instruction imparted, as during the regular term of lectures. This course, lasting through the month of October, has ever been interesting and valuable to the students.

Students after matriculating have the option of attending the lectures of one or more Professors, or of all, as may suit their convenience.

The fee for a course of lectures on a single branch is \$15.

To graduate, the student must previously have attended two full courses of lectures. He must be 21 years of age, have studied medicine under a preceptor three years, including the time spent in attending lectures, and be of good moral character. A Ticket from any reputable school counts a ticket here.

Boarding, in good houses, \$4 to \$5 a week.

When the student arrives in Nashville, he should come directly to the College and inquire for the Janitor, who will show him boarding-houses. Street cars run by the College door from the Public Square, nearly three miles out, branching in various directions. In good weather the student can walk, but in wet weather he can go in a car to his boarding-house, or any part of the city for five cents.

The Anatomical rooms will be opened on the first Monday in October, and every facility afforded for the prosecution of this important study.

By a method devised by the Professor of Physiology and Pathology in this Institution, it is now possible to preserve the subjects for dissection for any length of time, without decomposition. Not only are all the foul odors of the Dissecting-room thus destroyed, but all danger of accidents from dissecting wounds effectually removed.

### MEDICAL COLLEGE HOSPITAL.

The Faculty have taken steps to erect a large Hospital on the University-grounds, in connection with the Medical College.

This Hospital will be open for the reception of patients, on or before the 1st of October, 1867.

The students will have daily instruction in the Surgical, Obstetrical, and Fever wards of the Hospital, by members of the Faculty.

The immediate connection of the Hospital Building, with that of the Medical College, will afford unusual facilities for the daily study of the cases, at the bed-side, by the students.

### MEDICAL COLLEGE CLINIC.

More than one hundred important operations have been performed and cases presented before the Class, by the Professor of Surgery, during the past session, including five operations for Stone and six Amputations. These clinics in the College will be continued, by the Faculty, in addition to the instruction imparted at the bedside in the wards of the Hospital.
