

# **Tipper Gore to speak at Peabody Library 100th anniversary celebration**



Dean will be speaking at the Central Library about *American Medevac*, the film that tells the story of their reunion 40 years later.

Do you remember how finger painting was so much fun? If you like making art that's expressive and want some messy zen in your day, come to the paste paper


workshop Nov. 14. You'll work with mixed acrylics and paste, using a decorating technique that's hundreds of years old.

One of the most widely read humorists of the 20th century, Wodehouse was the author of more than 70 novels, 25 collections of short stories, 42 plays and musicals, 22 films and six autobiographical works.
