ANNOUNCEMENT.

THE regular course of instruction will begin on the first Monday of November, 1865, and end on the first day of March, 1866. The Museum, Cabinets, Library, Buildings, and appurtenances, are still as perfect as ever, and the old corps of teachers each in his place, except Professor Buchanan, removed by death, and whose place has been filled by Prof. Briggs, formerly Professor of Practical Anatomy.

The Anatomical Room will be opened on the first Monday in October, and every facility afforded for the prosecution of that corner-stone study.

Students after matriculating have the option of attending the lectures of one or more Professors, or of all, as may suit their convenience.

The fee for a course of lectures on a single branch is \$15.

To graduate, the student must previously have attended two full courses of lectures. He must be 21 years of age, have studied medicine under a preceptor three years, including the time spent in attending lectures, and be of good moral character. A Ticket from any reputable school counts as a ticket here.
